Directions

From A50: Junction 5 - A516 to Derby. Approximately 1 mile towards Derby, Ash Lane on the left signposted Sutton on the Hill.

From Derby: A38 towards Burton on Trent. First turning off is A516 to Uttoxeter/Stoke. Follow road for approximately 3 miles, straight over the first roundabout (A516) 3/4 - mile right turn is Ash Lane signposted Sutton on the Hill.

BARLEYFIELDS is just 20 yards on the right. It will be signposted from the A516. If reach the Tara Kadampa Meditation Centre – you have gone too far!

You may enter the venue from 8.00am and please park sensibly as space is limited.

The gates to the venue are electric and will open automatically when you approach.

Barleyfields is a riding school and livery yard so please be aware that there may be horses around and dogs must be on a lead at all times except when competing including walking to and from your vehicle.

Rules for Dogs

-  To be kept on leads at all times unless competing or exercising in the designated area.
-  Please do not take your dogs onto the yard where the horses are stabled.
-  **Please don't crowd the arena with dogs that are not running as there isn't a lot of room indoors.**
-  Rings will be netted to split both rings with a gap in between to help stop dogs jumping into the other ring!
-  **Please pick up after your dogs NO exceptions!**

Exercising Dogs

The exercise area is a footpath through the woodland behind the arena and stables or can walk down the long driveway. There is also a lovely walk if you head up to the main gates and turn left onto a bridle path or if turn right out of the gates there is access to a big field.



Pay on the Day Entries (POTD) – PLEASE REMEMBER TO Bring Proof of KC Measure and/or UKA Measure, unless obviously measures Large and is entered in Large, so we can add to the database if not already done so. If your dog hasn't been measured, please don't worry, just speak to one of the team when booking in.

- 🐾 We are taking entries, but please arrive in plenty of time to book in with a completed POTD entry form found on our website with all other show information. If you don't have access to a printer, there will be some provided.
- 🐾 If not sure what classes to enter or height of dog as not been measured, please ask one of the admin team who will be happy to help.
- 🐾 **Jump Heights** - No lower height option available apart from Smalls can choose Micro
- 🐾 Allsorts can choose any height apart from Large.
- 🐾 Veteran dogs must choose Medium, Small or Micro heights.

First Classes – Starters Agility & Allsorts Jumping

- 🐾 POTD entries for these classes must be completed and handed to one of the admin team **by 8:30am** at the latest in order to ensure we can start judging by 9am or as near to as we can!!

Course Walking

- 🐾 Will commence at 8:30am and Judging will start at 9.00am each day. Please be aware there may be slight delays if we have lots of pay on the day entries.

Some Things to Remember

- 🐾 Ensure no dangly bits (ID tags etc.,) on dog's collars.
- 🐾 Tit-bits or Food of any kind is not permitted in the ring either in the hand or in pockets etc.
- 🐾 Handlers in Starters classes may carry a silent toy in the ring but must not be thrown in the ring or at the end of your run.

Helping on the Rings

- 🐾 **Help setting up and packing up the rings is always very much appreciated.**
- 🐾 All competitors are required to help when and where they can.
- 🐾 We don't put the helper's sheets out but you have either chosen or are given a morning or afternoon slot & can be found on your running orders.
- 🐾 Please offer help on the ring that is looking like they need it! This helps make the day run as smoothly as possible and ensures we do not finish too late!
- 🐾 If you need support with what jobs need doing, please chat to one of our friendly ring managers who will be more than happy to help. Remember you learn lots and make some lovely friends whilst helping & this is how Agillidogz was originally set up!!

Steeplechase Qualifiers with Finals to be held at our 3-day September Show 2020 in Leicester

- 🐾 A straight forward flowing course with jumps and tunnels which will be suitable for all heights and levels and to be run as two classes (Large / Intermediate) (Medium / Small / Micro) over lunch with the top 5 from each qualifying class going through to the finals.

Agility & Jumping Finals to be held at our 3-day September Show 2020 in Leicester

- 🐾 The morning Agility & Jumping classes for Starters, Novice & Advanced will run as normal classes for results and the top 2 dogs in each level (Combined heights) will qualify for the finals. See website for further details.
- 🐾 The top 10 veteran dogs (over 9yrs) who compete in Allsorts classes and are genuine veteran dogs i.e. not competing in standard classes at other shows will be invited to compete in veteran finals.
